

What is Pay-by-App Parking?

All parking transactions are completed in ParkNYC App

- Leverages the app as payment mechanism eliminating the need to use a meter
- Will allow DOT to assess the viability of paid curb parking without physical meters
- May allow for future innovations, like Premium Loading Zones




Users are already transitioning to app-based payment

Pay-by App Pilot

6^{th} Avenue (14^{th} St $- 23^{rd}$ St)

- Existing 3-Hour Metered Parking M-F, Commercial Only; side streets also Commercial Only
- Meters will be removed and signage (regulatory and informational) will instruct drivers to use the app
- Metered commercial access and meters will be retained on east /west side streets
- In effect beginning January 9, 2023
- Enforcement: DOT + PD will coordinate on enforcement strategy and education





Pay-by-App Pilot

 6^{th} Avenue (14^{th} St $- 23^{rd}$ St)

- Physical meters will remain on side streets
- Most spaces in the area will continue to have a physical meter option
- Total commercial spaces on 6th Ave corridor + side streets: 650
 - Pay-by-App Only: 68 (10%)
 - Physical Meter Commercial: 582 (90%)

Signage And Implementation

- Rider sign indicating app payment added below existing parking regulations sign
- Recently redesigned ParkNYC app has improved payment options and user experience
- Additional informational signs will be installed on sign poles
- Users may pay by phone but must first register on ParkNYC. Once registered, call (800) 428-4027 to pay by phone



PAY-BY-APP ONLY PARKING

NYC Department of Transportation (DOT) is piloting Pay-by-App Only parking for Commercial spaces on 6th Ave, between 14th St and 23rd St. The pilot will allow DOT to test payby-app only parking regulations in NYC.

What you need to know:

- Individuals must pay for regulated parking using the ParkNYC app, NYC's mobile app for metered parking payment.
- A pay-by-phone option is also available. Those wishing to pay by phone must first register on ParkNYC and follow instructions on the app.
- Physical meters have been removed on 6th
 Ave but will remain on the side streets.
 Everyone parking on 6th Ave must use
 ParkNYC. Meter receipts will not be a valid form of payment on 6th Ave.
- All other existing meter regulations remain in effect.

Implementation


- January 9, 2023 launch date

Beginning January 9, 2023, NYC Department of Transportation (NYC DOT) will begin a Commercial Pay-by-App only pilot on 6th Ave, between 14th St and 23rd St. The pilot will allow DOT to test pay-by-app only parking regulations in NYC for the first time.


What you need to know about the Pilot:

- Individuals must pay for regulated parking using the ParkNYC app, NYC's mobile app for metered parking payment.
- A pay by phone option will be available. Those wishing to pay by phone must first register on ParkNYC. After registering, call 800.428.4027 to pay by phone.
- Physical meters will be removed on 6th Ave but will remain on the side streets. However those parking on 6th Ave must use ParkNYC. Meter receipts will not be a valid form of payment on 6th Ave.
- All other parking regulations remain in effect.
