## QUEENS BLVD. - 74TH ST. TO ELIOT AVE. CORRIDOR SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

Eliminate Highway-Like  
Design Features

Shorten Crossing Distances

NYC DOT will implement safety improvements along Queens Blvd. from 74th St. to Eliot Ave.:

- Install protected pedestrian path and bicycle lane along service road medians
- Redesign slip lanes between mainline and service road
- Install new mall-to-mall crosswalks to connect service road medians
- Implement signal timing improvements at Broadway/Grand Ave.
- Install bus only markings for bus stop on westbound Queens Blvd. service road in front of Queens Center Mall
- Install pedestrian improvements at 90th St.
- Install new crosswalks at Eliot Ave.

## Implementation starts in July
