Calm Traffic

NYC DOT will implement safety and transit improvements on Jay and Smith Streets between Tillary Street and State Street:

- Restrict traffic on Jay Street between Tillary Street and Livingston Street to buses, trucks, and local access only (no thru traffic), Monday through Friday, 7 AM - 7 PM
- Install new protected bike lanes on Smith Street between State Street and Fulton Street
- Add protected bike lane on Jay Street between Johnson Street and Tillary Street
- Reverse direction of traffic on Johnson Street between Adams Street and Jay Street and install a protected bike lane
- Install painted pedestrian refuge islands at Livingston Street, Metrotech Roadway, Myrtle Plaza, and Johnson Street

Implementation starts in Late August
