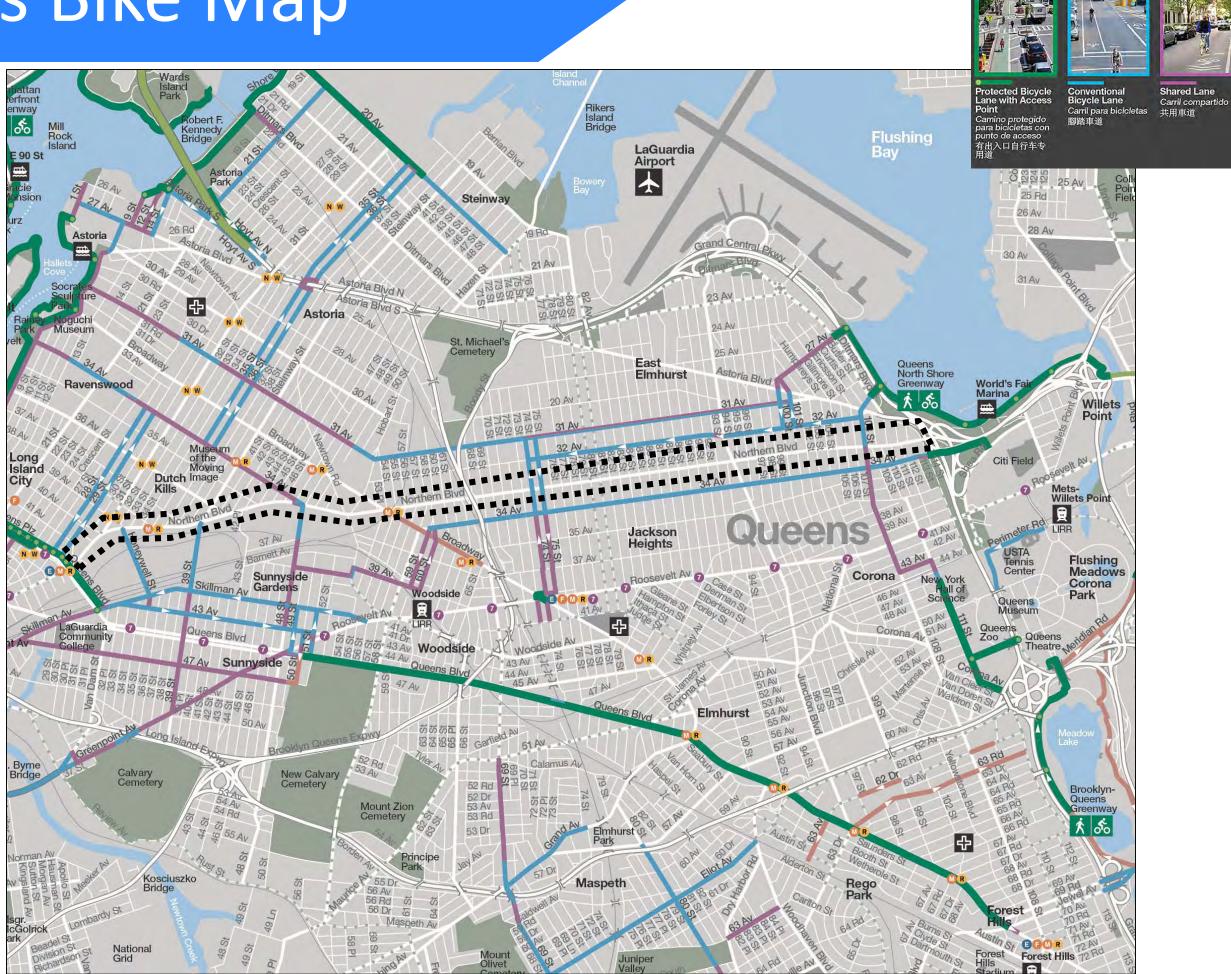




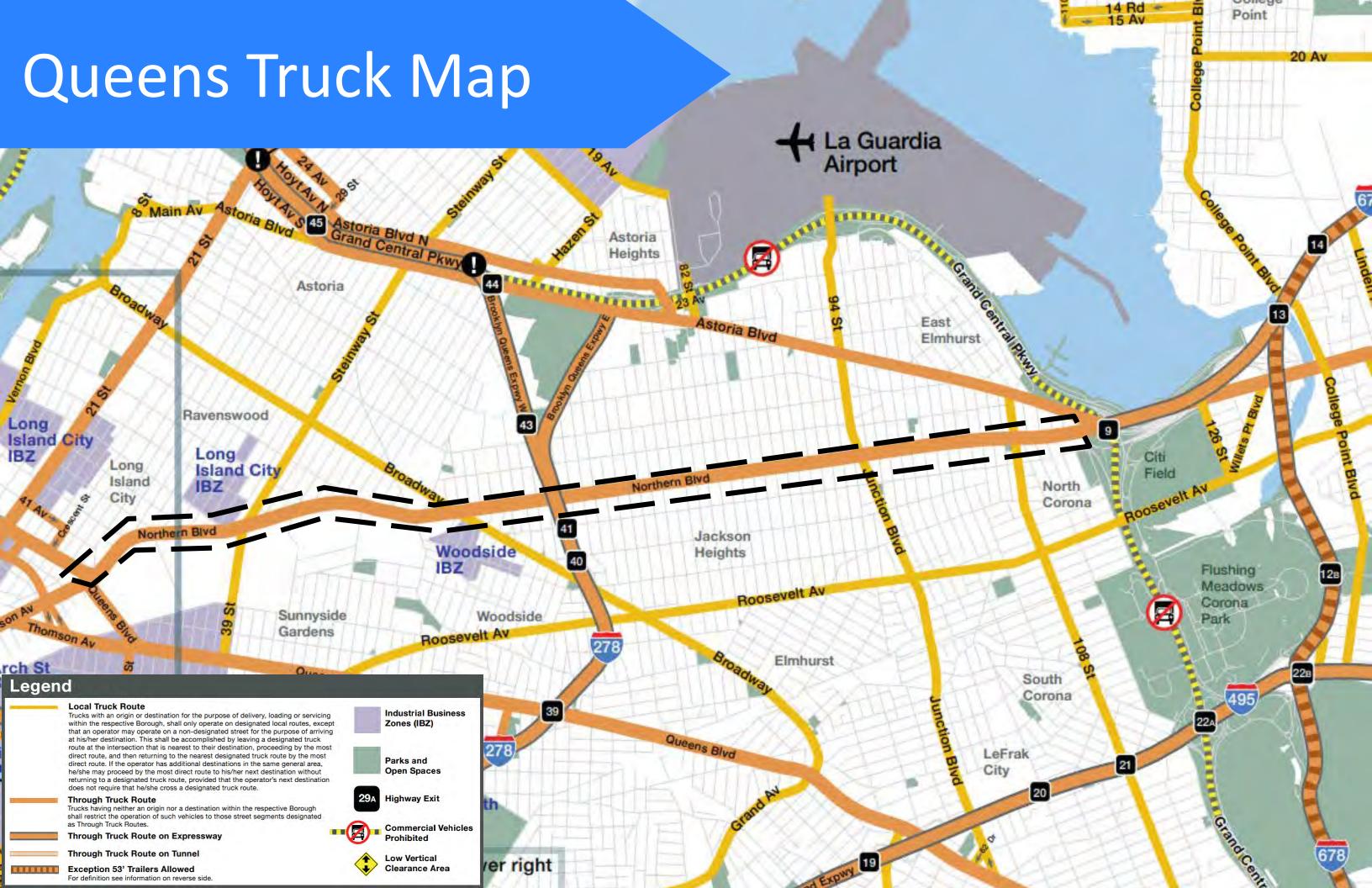
Buses on Northern Blvd: QM2, QM3, QM 20, QM 32, Q101, Q102, Q66




## Previous Safety Improvements on Northern Blvd

- Between 2014 and 2018, NYC DOT completed the following safety improvements on Northern Blvd in Community Board 1 and Community Board 2:
  - Constructed 7 pedestrian safety islands at 33<sup>rd</sup> St, 34<sup>th</sup> St, 39<sup>th</sup> Ave, 48<sup>th</sup> St, 61<sup>st</sup> St, and 62<sup>nd</sup> St (2014 2017)
  - Constructed curb extensions at 48<sup>th</sup> St and 34<sup>th</sup> Ave (2017)
  - Banned 2 left turns at 39<sup>th</sup> Ave and 61<sup>st</sup> St (2014 and 2016)
  - Installed 10 second Leading Pedestrian Intervals (LPI) at all feasible intersections (typical LPI is 7 seconds) (2018)
  - Installed high-visibility crosswalks and refurbished markings between Queens Plaza and 68<sup>th</sup> St (2014 2018)

#### Safety Data: Northern Boulevard (Queens Plaza to 68 St)

- ☐ Vision Zero Priority Corridor & Area
- ☐ 35 people killed or severely injured (2012 2016) and 5 pedestrian fatalities (2012 present) along 2 mile corridor
- ☐ Highest cause of vehicle occupant injuries result from rear end crashes (33.6%) and sideswipe crashes (21.6%)



#### **Short Term Improvements**

- In 2019, NYC DOT plans to install concrete pedestrian refuge space on Northern Blvd at Broadway, Newtown Rd, and Woodside Ave
- By 2021, NYC DOT plans to install an additional 8 pedestrian refuge islands between 36<sup>th</sup> St and 50<sup>th</sup> St
