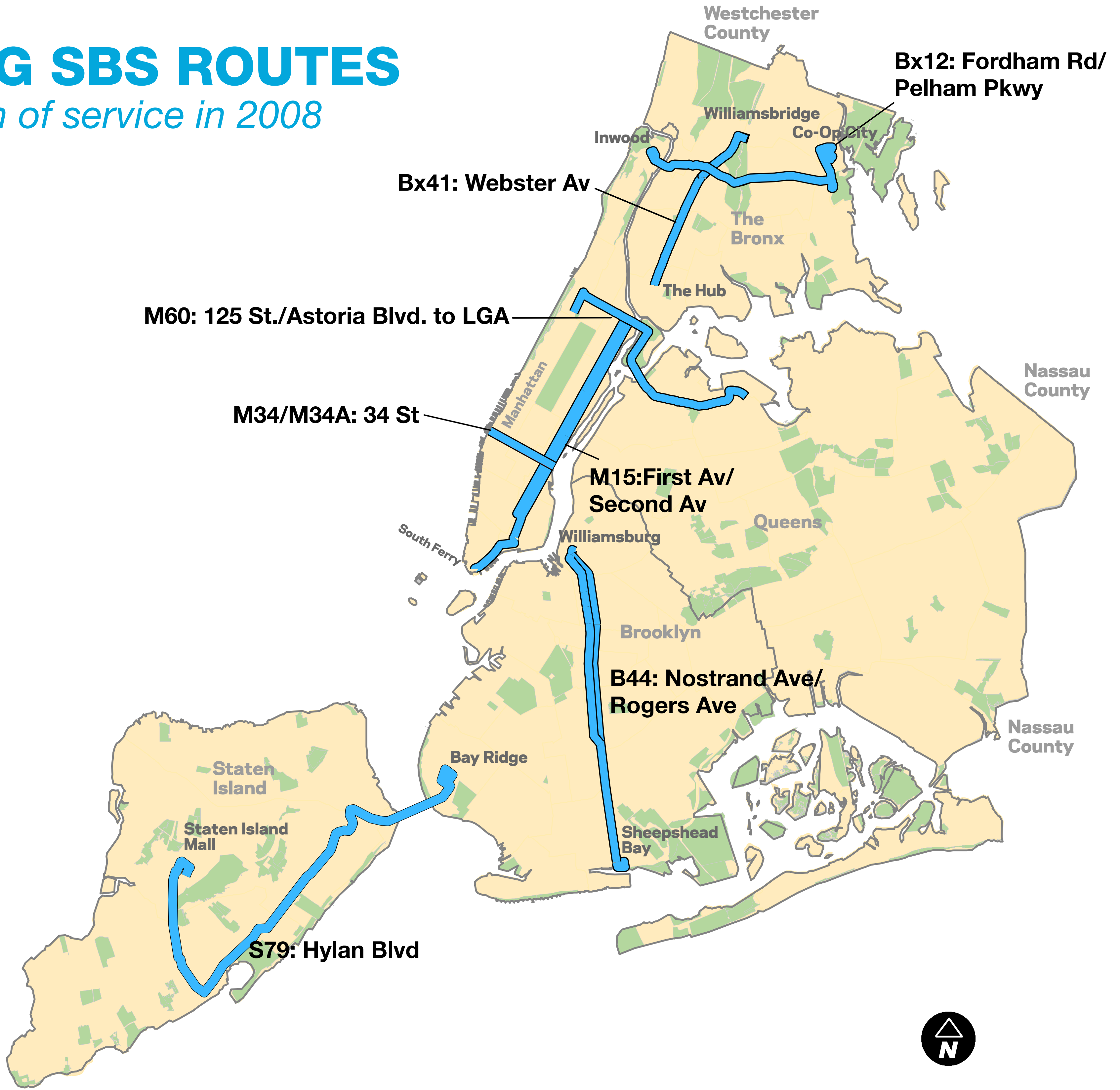

BUILDING A BETTER TRANSIT NETWORK

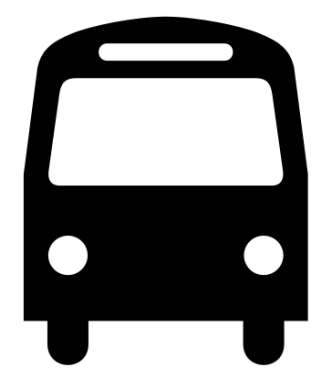
Select Bus Service (SBS) Select Bus Service is New York City’s brand name for a package of improvements that result in faster and more reliable service on high-ridership bus routes. There are seven SBS routes currently operating in NYC.

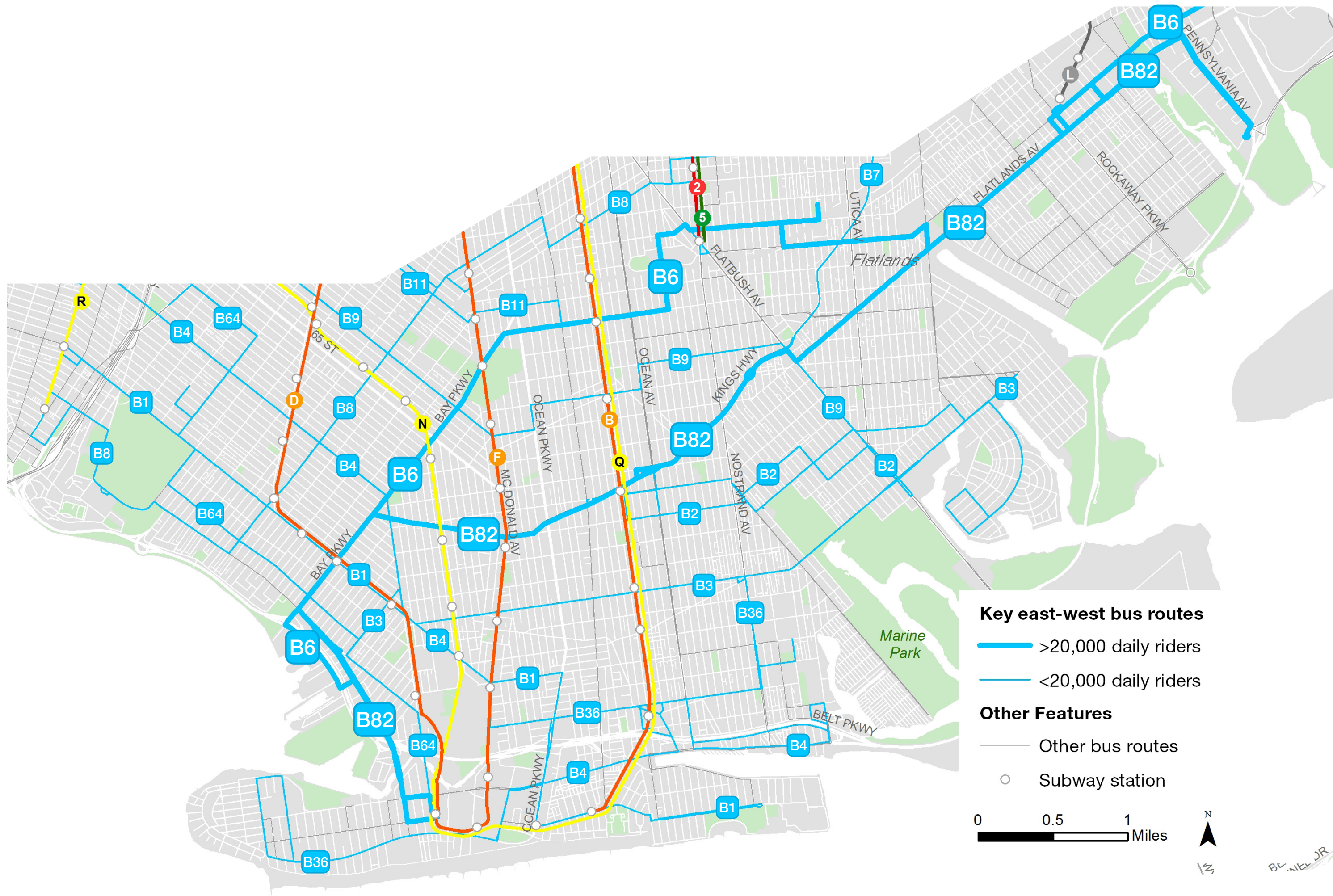

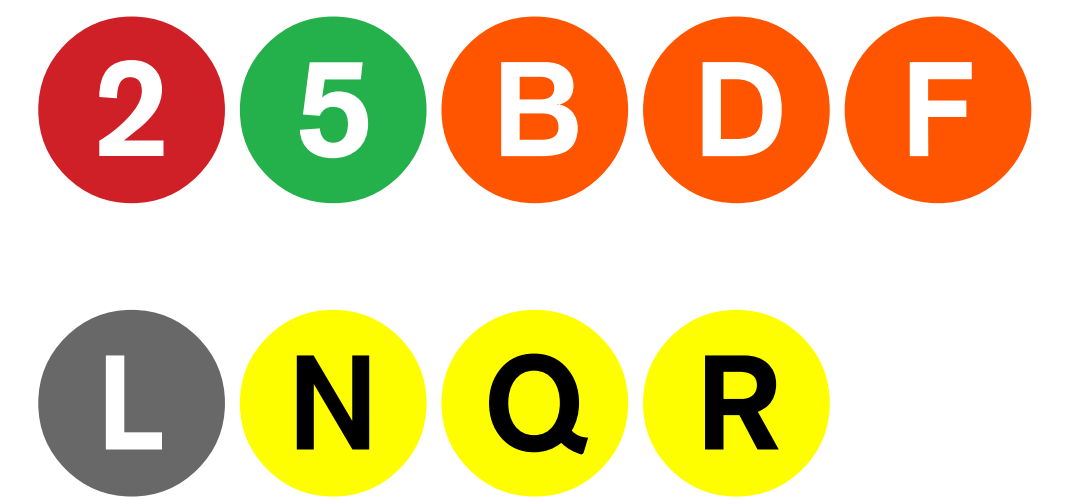

TRANSIT SERVICE IN SOUTH BROOKLYN



9 subway routes serve south Brooklyn and mainly run North-South.



14 bus routes provide East-West service

with a *combined ridership* of

The Bus Rapid Transit Phase II Study (2009) identified the south Brooklyn east-west corridor as a *priority service need*.

Key issues raised at the 2009 public workshops included the following:

- Bus trips are *long* and *slow*
- Many parts of south Brooklyn are *underserved* by transit
- A bus trip across south Brooklyn can take *up to 2 hours*

WAYS TO IMPROVE BUS SERVICE

Dedicated Bus Lanes



Faster bus rides

Reduced traffic conflicts
between buses and other traffic

Signal Priority for Buses



Buses spend **less time stopped** at red lights

More reliable bus service

Off-Board Fare Collection



Quicker bus boarding

All-Door Boarding



Buses spend **less time waiting** at bus stops

WAYS TO IMPROVE BUS SERVICE

Improved Station Amenities



More attractive, appealing bus stops

More comfortable wait for the bus

Better information for riders to *know when* the bus is coming

Real-Time Passenger Information



Better visibility for pedestrians, bus operators, and drivers

Clearer, shorter pedestrian crossings

Pedestrian Safety Improvements
