Program Context


PROCESS

- Application based
- Fully supported by Community at public presentation on 2/26/2019
- Community Board approved
- Typically installed along the parking lane
- Varying design types
- Seasonal March until December




STANDARD DESIGN

- 6 feet wide
- 20' feet long segments
- Platform flush with the curb
- Plastic pallet subsurface
- Deck tile finish
- Planter boxes
- Stainless steel cables
- Moveable furniture



SAFETY



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OPERATION

- > All seating open to public
- No alcohol or smoking allowed
- No commercial activity (e.g., waiter service)
- Moveable furniture closed or removed & stored by partner
- Partner responsible for maintenance via an agreement



BENEFITS

- More active street life
- Transformation of parking spaces for people
- Better visibility
- Traffic calming
- Daylighting
- Economic incentives
