



Thomson Ave Outreach








Survey Data Results




Majority of the participants were Asian and male. Although there was a sizeable number of participants who were Hispanic/Latino or Black/African American. There was also a high female participation rate in the surveys.




Almost half of the surveys were done during the LaGuardia Health Fair, the other half were done outside LaGuardia Community College's E Building. Also, majority of the respondents were between the ages of 18-34.




A large portion of the survey participants were students at LaGuardia Community College. Majority of the participants used to subway to get to their destinations in the neighborhood.





More than half of the participants said that the sidewalks are usually over-crowded making it difficult to move. A sizeable percentage of people also claimed that the sidewalks are usually crowded. None of the respondents chose, "Nearly Empty", as their response to this question.







Overwhelming majority of the participants were delayed in some manner because of the sidewalk congestion.





Most people choose not to ride a bike mainly because of a combination of three things. They don't like riding in the street with cars, their destination is too far or they don't own or have access to a bike.







Participants were asked to rank their desirable SIPs in order, 1 being the most desirable and 5 being the least desirable. Participants overwhelmingly chose Expanded Sidewalks as their 1st choice and No Changes as their 5th choice.


Ratings	Category

2.56	Parked Cars to Protect from Traffic during peak hours
2.79	Bikes Lanes on Thomson
2.85	Drop Off/Loading Zones
4.79	No Changes

Majority of pedestrians thought it was somewhat safe, while a sizeable amount did say they felt somewhat unsafe from traffic. Majority of cyclists felt very unsafe from traffic on Thomson Ave. Mostof the drivers felt somewhat safe when asked about their level of safety while driving around Thomson Ave.






Pedestrian Route Heat Map of frequently used walking routes along Thomson Ave




Pedestrian Route Heat Map of frequently used biking routes along Thomson Ave

Combination of origin and destination points of respondents' travel patterns around Thomson Ave.


